About this fact sheet

The Gresham-Barlow School Board is considering placing a school bond proposal before the voters. On average, schools in the district are more than 40 years old. Some are close to 100 years old. A committee spent several months creating a long-range plan outlining the district's facility needs. One key recommendation of the committee was that the school board consider going out for a school bond to help pay for those needs.

At a glance—projects under consideration

A school bond measure would impact every school in the district.

Some of the projects under consideration include:

- Improved teaching and learning spaces
- Additional classrooms to provide enough space for all-day kindergarten, to replace aging modular buildings/portable classrooms, and to make room for increasing enrollment
- New and improved classrooms with technology upgrades to support a robust Career Technical Education Program (CTE) and Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) classes
- Improvements to gyms, fields, and performing arts spaces for school and community use
- Replacement of roofs, siding, electrical and plumbing components and seismic and security upgrades

- The school district is hosting eight community forums where people can find out more about the projects listed above and share their ideas and opinions.
- All of the district-wide forums will feature the same format and information. We encourage you to attend the forum that works best for your schedule.
- There are three schools where more significant changes are envisioned: Gresham High School, West Gresham Elementary School, and Deep Creek Elementary School. The site-specific forums will focus on the specific proposal for that school.
